

PORTFOLIO

The Purpose of a portfolio is to demonstrate your versatility, breath of experiences, engagements, achievements, and organizational skill. Portfolio can include;

- 1.1 Academics; projects, research, papers
 - 1.2 Awards, competition
 - 1.3 Arts and Design; a range of media such as drawing, painting, collage, photography, sculpture, model, prototype, any designs, performance, or sketchbook pages.
 - 1.4 Visual media, animation, film, VDOs and audios length limitation are 3 minutes. Standard platforms, e.g. YouTube, Instagram, sites.google.com are encouraged.
 - 1.5 Abroad experiences; such as exchange program, internships, international workshop.
 - 1.6 Internships, past work experiences.
 - 1.7 Business, marketing, branding, sale, fundraising.
 - 1.8 Social / Community activities and projects
 - 1.9 Extra curricular activities / special abilities; such as sports, music, theatre, marathon, hiking.
 - 1.10 Continuing education; short courses, certificates.
- Portfolio reveals a great deal about the author. Be critical about what you put inside.
 - Select only the best ones that represent your experiences and achievements. Please refrain from including family or photo of trip from abroad. Organizational structure is as important as the content.
 - Special attention must be paid to the quality of reproduction of the original work. For instance, try to have your drawing scanned rather than photographing it by yourself. If scanning is not an option due to size of

work, digital camera with a minimum of eight – ten mega pixel camera with appropriate lighting set up with suffice.

- **Upload a PDF file. One File. A4 document size. No more than 10 pages or 10 MB file size.**
- Paste a URL link to candidate's media or online portfolio. Make sure you set an appropriate link sharing permission for the school to access and grade. Inaccessible links may be result in an unqualified submission.
- **All the content in the portfolio must be exclusively yours.**
