



## School of Integrated Innovation Scholarship Opportunities for BAScii Students

The School of Integrated Innovation is pleased to announce a number of scholarships for both Thai and international students in the BAScii Program. To be eligible for these scholarships, the students will be assessed according to either their academic merit, financial need or extracurricular contribution. There are four broad categories of scholarships:

### 1. Merit scholarships (academic achievements)

These scholarships, based on the student's excellence of performance are for both Thai and International students, and provide a 100,000THB reduction in tuition fees for the first semester of degree study.

#### Eligibility:

A. Thai students

Applicants must display outstanding academic merit with admission scores in the top 20% of all admitted Thai students.

B. International students (Foreign-passport holders only)

Applicants must display outstanding academic merit with admission scores in the top 40% of all admitted foreign students.

For remaining semesters, the 100,000THB reduction in tuition fee scholarship will be determined based on the student's ranking in the program at the end of each previous semester.

### 2. Recognition Performance Scholarships

These scholarships lay emphasis on factors other than academic excellence. Students are assessed on the basis of their extracurricular activities or contribution to the society that reflect well on Chulalongkorn University or the BAScii program during their study. The value of this scholarship is up to a 100,000THB reduction in tuition fees per semester after the assessment.

Students who received **Merit scholarships** are ineligible for a **Recognition Performance Scholarship** within the same semester.

### 3. Need-Based Scholarships (disadvantage)

Need-based aid is aimed at students from low socio-economic backgrounds, who display outstanding academic merit but have no means to finance their studies. The scholarships provide a 100,000THB reduction in tuition fee for the first semester of degree study. However, students need to provide supporting documentation to substantiate their needs.

For remaining semesters, the recipients of the 100,000THB reduction in tuition fee scholarship will be evaluated based on their academic performance. However, students need to provide supporting documentation to substantiate the veracity of their need.

Students who received **Merit Scholarships** are ineligible for a **Need-based scholarship** within the same semester.

#### **4. On-demand Project Scholarships**

In addition to University funding, there are many elements of the public and private sector that request BAScii students to work on their on-demand projects. The number of scholarships, amount of funding, and project requirements vary each year but will be announced to BAScii students at the beginning of each semester.

Students who already receive one of the first three types of scholarships can apply for these project scholarships as well.

The BAScii program committee reserves the right to select the students for the scholarships and could change the scholarship policy at all times; however, we expect to maintain a consistent number of scholarship places at a consistent rate each year.
