for the Academic Year 2019 (Early Admission)

The candidate selection for the admission to the Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation (International program) School of Integrated Innovation Chulalongkorn University for the Academic Year 2019 (Early Admission) has been completed.

The School of Integrated Innovation, Chulalongkorn University is to announce 71 accepted applicants (as per Appendix I) for the Academic Year 2019 (Early Admission). To proceed with the admission process, applicants admitted to the Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation (International program) must confirm their rights for enrollment as Chulalongkorn students on **Friday 8th February 2019 during 8:00- 16:00** with an applicant's Identity card for Thai students and a passport for non-Thai students, including its copy, and a payment slip for the enrollment confirmation fee of 100,000 (THB) at the BAScii admission office (19 floor, Chamchuri 10 building).

Those admitted applicants who cannot come in person may designate a representative to come on his/her behalf. The representative must bring 1) a delegation letter written and signed by the admitted applicant, 2) a copy of the admitted applicant's Identity card (Thai students) or a copy of the admitted applicant's passport (non-Thai students) including 3) a copy of the representative's Identity card.

The payment for the confirmation fee must be done through the following link <http://inter-bascii-chula.com> **between 5-8 February 2019**. Enter the applicants' data and print out the bank payment form and pay the confirmation fee (100,000THB) at the designated banks. Refunds cannot be made in any case. Failure to do so will result in an admission rejection.
